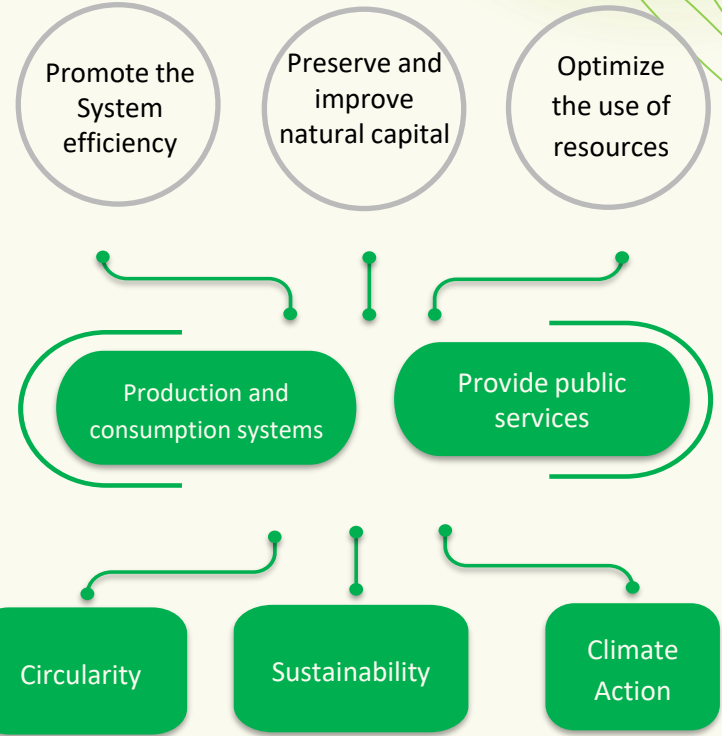


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Main Pillars towards of Bogotá circular

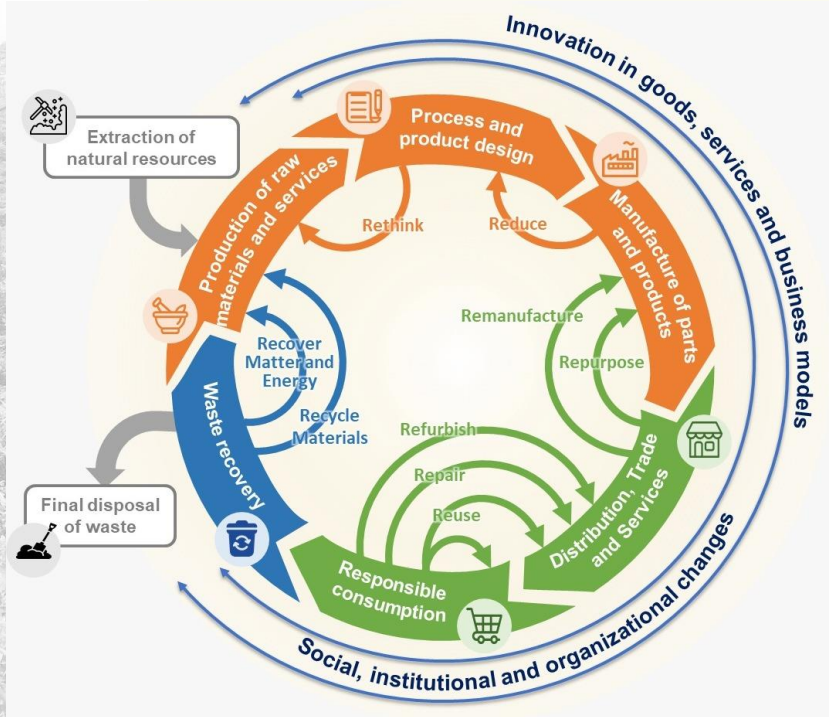

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Guiding principles of this transformation:



1. Governance and co-responsibility of the different actors for its implementation.
2. Systemic vision that integrates all links in the chain.
3. Vertical and horizontal integrality in public policies and regulatory framework.
4. Innovation both in process, as well as in products and markets, with knowledge management.
5. Circular opportunities that increase private sector productivity and competitiveness.

Problematic



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Prevalence of linear economy models based on the extraction and transformation of resources for the production, consumption of goods and services, and the inadequate management of their waste.

Prioritized strategic factors



Linear processes in the production and consumption of goods and services.



Prevalence of unsustainable cultural habits.



Low levels of reuse, use and differentiated treatment of waste.



Disarticulation of actors and inefficiency of regulatory and economic instruments; due to disarticulation of the academic, business, government and citizenship sectors.

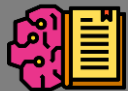
